

Entering Quilts in the 2020 Hauptstrasse Quiltfest Outdoor Show

Registration Deadline: April 29th

After April 29th we are unable to accommodate changes to your registrations except to eliminate a quilt that is already registered. You will receive a receipt when your drop off your quilt.

Each quilt entry requires a Registration Form, Quilt ID Tag & Photo of the finished quilt. Photos should be submitted with the quilt at the time of drop off. Photos can be printed off of a color printer at home an actual "photograph" is not required. **We will not accept quilts without a photo.**

Definition of a quilt for our Show:

A quilt is two layers of fabric with a filling that is stitched together with lines or a pattern. Quilting may be done by hand or by machine. Quilts do not need to have a sleeve for our show.

Size:

We cannot accept stuffed animals, tablecloths, pillow shams or other non-quilt items. Shapes other than squares and rectangles are discouraged and may not be displayed due to difficulty in hanging in our show.

General Registration:

Please use the document titled "Quilt Registration".

Sale Quilts:

Quilts entered for sale must adhere to copyright law. Please use the document titled "Quilt Sales Registration". Boerne Parks & Recreation will handle all sales and will retain a 15% commission. Sales Tax will be collected at the time of sale and will be remitted by the City. Checks will be processed and mailed within 2 weeks of the show for any quilts sold.

Liability Release:

Quilts in the show are hung outdoors. Each exhibitor must sign a Release Agreement included in the paper registration or online registration. An adult is required to sign the release for any entrant under the age of 18.

Photography:

Quilts may be photographed by show attendees and the media. Submission of a quilt constitutes permission by the quilter/owner for it to be photographed. The City of Boerne may use images of any quilt submitted for promotional purposes.

Boerne Parks & Recreation reserves the right not to display quilts that do not meet the Entry Criteria & Requirements.

I understand that reasonable care will be taken to protect my quilt prior too, during the Quiltfest, and subsequent to my picking up the entry after the show. Reasonable care will be provided through the use of "Quilt Angels" who will supervise the display and viewing of the exhibits. I understand that any responsibility for loss or damage to my quilt or exhibited item can be assumed by the City of Boerne, businesses displaying quilts, or the volunteers conducting the Quiltfest. I have read and understand the rules and procedures for entering the Boerne Quiltfest sponsored by the City of Boerne Parks & Recreation Department.

I understand that this is an outdoor event.

SALE AGREEMENT

The City of Boerne, will be responsible for collecting and remitting sales taxes to the state. The City of Boerne will take all payments for quilts including sales tax at the event. The city will issue payment back to the seller for the price of the quilt, less a 15% commission and sales tax. Please allow two weeks post date of event for submission of checks
